Thought as we enter to worship:

The Westminster Confession, as a statement of faith, was an effort to reform the Church of England to make in greater conformity with the Church of Scotland and was adopted by the Church of Scotland in 1648. From this statement sprang a catechism; a list of 107 questions with answers to be taught to children of Presbyterians. The first is the most famous of those questions: “What is the chief end of man?” meaning, “Why were we created, what is our purpose?” The answer: “The chief end of man is to glorify God and enjoy him forever”.

That is the reason we were created.

We were made to make God look good in the eyes of the world around us and we were made to have a relationship with God as a friendship to enjoy.
